


WHAT

- Standalone tool that tracks the movements of Italian victims of Shoah through an interactive visualization
- Movement = trajectory from one georeferenced place where a dated event took place to another
- Based on Linked Open Data (*thanks to Laura Brazzo and Silvia Mazzini!*)
- Freely available: <http://dh.fbk.eu/technologies/lod-navigator>




WHY

- Holocaust was “a profoundly geographical phenomenon” (Knowles et al., 2014)
- Visualizations can help:
 - generating new questions and new knowledge about Nazis’ genocidal policies
 - reconstructing stories of groups of victims and individuals



HOW

- Four steps:
 1. Data observation
 2. Data extraction
 3. Data integration & manipulation
 4. Data visualization








3) DATA INTEGRATION & MANIPULATION

- Adding of country of origin
 - extracted from the *abstract* field
 - Italy plus other 36 countries covering 49% of the victims (plus *unknown*)

3) DATA INTEGRATION & MANIPULATION

- Georeferencing of place names with Nominatim
 - 1493 unique places / 15% manually corrected or georeferenced: E.g.: Siena





4) DATA VISUALIZATION

- Interactive interface
 - Search by name or place (with auto-complete function)
 - Timeline
 - Filters: *country of origin / occupation / death description / gender*
 - Fly-over functionality
 - Link to CDEC digital library



SOME NUMBERS

- What is visualized in the LOD Navigator
 - 8,963 persons with at least 1 movement
 - 18,813 movements between 37,626 non-unique places

CONCLUSIONS

- Tool for digital history
- Freely available
- Reuse of a LOD dataset
- Focus on the spatiality of the Holocaust
- Identification of spatiotemporal patterns but also representation of individual experiences

POSSIBLE FUTURE DEVELOPMENTS

- From standalone application to web application
- New filters
- Trace movements of families
- Visually deal with uncertainty
- Extend input data with similar information available in other databases
